

RAYLEIGH WATERWORKS DISTRICT

BY-LAW NUMBER 112

A bylaw to repeal Bylaw No. 104, being the bylaw for fixing tolls and other charges payable to the District and the terms payment thereof, and providing for a percentage addition to encourage prompt payment thereof.

The Trustees of the Rayleigh Waterworks District
ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1. The following tolls are hereby fixed and made payable by all owners and occupants of the premises in the District to which water is delivered from the works of the District:
 - a) In respect to each dwelling, a monthly toll of \$15.75 plus \$15.75 per month for each unit of a multiple family dwelling.
 - b) In respect of each restaurant, cafe, pubs and the likes, a monthly toll of \$1.00 per licensed seat.
 - c) In respect of each trailer camp, a monthly toll of \$21.00.
 - d) In respect of each motel, a monthly charge of \$8.35 per unit per month, plus \$21.00 for motel.
 - e) In respect of agricultural purposes, ie. stock watering, hobby farms etc., a monthly charge of \$15.75.
 - f) In respect of each school, a fee of \$15.75 plus \$8.40 per classroom per month.
 - g) In respect of each garage or service station, a monthly charge of \$22.30 per month.
2. The aforesaid tolls shall be due and payable as stated on the statement, and any tolls remaining unpaid after the due date shall have added thereto a percentage addition of ten percent (10%) thereof.
3. The Trustees may, on 24 hours written notice, by resolution order the water shut off to any premises on which there are any tolls or other charges owing for sixty days or longer from the due date. Water shut off under this section shall be subject to the charges levied under Section 4 of this bylaw.
4. In addition to the aforementioned charges, there is fixed and made payable to the District by every owner or occupier of premises in respect to which a written request is made for the water supply be turned off, or on the order of the Trustees that the water supply be turned off, a charge of \$35.00. There is also fixed and made payable to the District by every owner or occupier of premises in respect to which a written request is made that the water be turned on, a charge of \$35.00.

5. This bylaw may be cited as the "Tolls Bylaw, 1996".
6. This bylaw repeals Bylaw No. 104.
